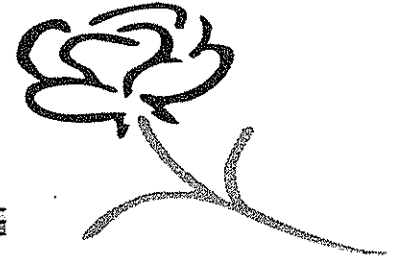


Memo
