HEALTH & MEDICAL FORMS

All health forms, physicals and the online health form must be completed and turned in by the start of camp. We will be posting a COVID health form as it becomes available. COVID testing may be necessary. We will inform you when we have more guidance from the NYS Health Department.

CAMP REGISTRATION

Registration will look a little different this year. We are planning to hold registration outside (weather permitting). The nurse will be your first stop. Temperatures will be taken, and pre-screening questions will be asked of each camper. Once you have been cleared by the nurse, your next stop will be with the Camp Manager to pay any remaining camp balances.

**If you have paid in full prior to registration, you may skip this line and go directly to the Assistant Camp Manager to purchase a Snack/Camp Store Card* Your last stop will be with your Camp Director to receive your cabin assignment

MASKS

Masks will likely be necessary during times when campers are gathering as a group for activities.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We are planning to set up some outdoor space to allow for larger groups to gather safely. Campers will do much of the day's activities with their cabin mates such as dining and pool time. Social distancing will be coordinated with the camp directors.

SANITIZING & PERSONAL HYGIENE

Hand sanitizer stations will be set up outside each of our large buildings. Campers will need to use the hand sanitizer upon entering and exiting the building. Frequent hand washing is will be encouraged. Hand sanitizer will also be available in every cabin. Large buildings and playground equipment will be sanitized during rest hour.

POOL

We will be limiting the number of swimmers in the pool at a time according to NYS guidelines. Shower rooms and railings will be sanitized between groups.

CLEANING

All buildings cabins will be cleaned and sanitized 24 hours before campers arrive. Bathrooms will be cleaned regularly throughout the day.

DINING

Campers will dine with their cabin mates for each meal. All meals will be served by kitchen staff and we will be using all disposable dinnerware. Trash receptacles will be placed at the end of each table.
