Youth Camp General Information

Check-in/out times

- Check in is from 2:00-4:00 PM on Sunday for all camps with the following exceptions: Pilgrim Camp checks in from 2:00 - 3:00 PM Senior High Camp checks in from 3:00 - 4:00 pm
- **Check out** is generally between 9:00 10:00 am. If your camp is having a presentation, your Camp Director will let you know what time your presentation will be and where it will be held on Saturday.

Health Forms

(Forms can either be uploaded directly to your account once completed or emailed/mailed to the camp office. The addresses are on the form)

<u>Camper Medical/Immunization Form</u> - This form MUST be printed from your account and given to your child's physician to fill out and be returned. This form gives our Health Director permission to administer medications, both prescription and OTC. This form MUST be filled out and signed even if your child doesn't take any medications.

Physical - NYS requires a current physical for your child to attend camp.

Immunization Records - NYS requires a copy of your child's immunization records for your child to attend camp. If your child is not getting immunizations, the NYS Health Dept requires us to have a written letter explaining why your child is not getting immunizations.

<u>Mental Health Form</u> - This is an online fillable form that automatically stays in your child's account. It does not need to be printed.

<u>Health History Form</u> - This form also stays in your child's account and does not need to be printed. This form gives us permission to have your child treated in the event of an emergency.

Children with Special Needs

We are a non-profit camp that runs solely on volunteers and have limited expertise with child behaviors. We are not equipped to handle children who need extra or one on one supervision. This would require an aide to stay at camp with your child.

Dietary - We provide for dietary needs such as Gluten Free or any other food allergies

Child must be able or willing to participate in camp activities.

Child must be able to dress and shower themselves and have basic hygiene skills.
