GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

Pet Policies – NO PETS ALLOWED This means you cannot bring your dog to swim lessons, registration (drop off or pick up), church picnics or any other event, function or camp. If you have a service dog, please call the office for our policy. Companion dogs are not considered service dogs.

<u>Check-in/out times</u> – (Youth Camps) With the exception of Senior High Camp, which checks in at 3:00 pm, all youth camps check in time is 2:00 pm. Check out is generally between 9:00 am – 10:00 am unless your camp is having a presentation and if so, your Camp Director will let you know at check in, what time to be here for the presentation.

(Family Camps) Check in is from 2:00 - 4:00 pm. Everyone must report to the office and check in on Sunday. If you arrive after 4:00 pm, please check in at the office ASAP the following day.

(Weekend Camps) Check in is at from 6:30 – 7:00 pm at Pilgrim Lodge and pick up is on Sunday following a slide show at 1:30 pm.

<u>Payment policy</u> – Camp fees should be PAID IN FULL before coming to camp. If you are unable to pay your balance in full prior to coming to camp, then it must be paid upon arrival. *Having your fees paid and your medical forms turned in prior to camp will get you through the registration process quicker!

<u>Leaving camp during the week</u> (Youth Camps) If your child needs to leave camp during his/her stay at camp, you must sign them out before you leave and sign them back in when you return. Please notify your Camp Director ahead of time if your child needs to leave camp during the week.

<u>Guests & Volunteers</u> – ALL guests (Family Camps only) and Volunteers must check in. If you are volunteering for Buildings & Grounds, please check in with Jorge or Larry. If you are a guest at camp, please check in at the Office located up at the barn upon arrival.

Health Forms – (Youth Camps)

- 1. <u>Camper Medical Form</u> This form MUST be printed from your account and given to your child's physician to fill out and return. The form gives our Health Director permission to administer medications, both prescription and OTC. This form MUST be filled out even if your child does not take any medications.
- 2. Physical We require a current physical for your child to attend camp.
- 3. <u>Immunization records</u> We require a copy of your child's immunization records for your child to attend camp. <u>If your child is not getting immunizations</u>, the NYS Health Dept. requires a written <u>letter form the parent explaining why your child is not vaccinated</u>.
- 4. <u>Mental Health Form</u> This is an online fillable form that automatically stays in your child's account. It does not need to be printed.
- 5. <u>Health History Form</u> This form also stays in your child's account and does not need to be printed. This form gives us permission to have your child treated in the event of an emergency.

Health Forms – (Family Camps)

- 1. <u>Adult Medical Form</u> All adults must fill out this form so that we know how to help you in the event of an emergency.
- 2. Youth medical forms are not necessary because children are at camp with family.

<u>Children with Special Needs</u> – We are a non-profit camp that runs solely on volunteers and we have limited experience with child behaviors. We are not equipped to handle children who need extra or one on one supervision. This would require an aide to stay at camp with your child.

- Dietary we provide for dietary needs such as Gluten Free or any other food allergies.
- Child must be able to participate in camp activities.
- Child must be able to dress & shower themselves and have basic hygiene skills.
