Swim tests will be given at 4:00 PM; ALL campers will need to take a swim test on Sunday and should plan to participate in this activity with their cabin-mates.

Registration space is still available, so invite more friends to come with you, however, as space does fill up it will be harder to honor cabin mate requests.

**Camp closes at 10:00 AM on Saturday, Aug 1st.** All campers should be picked up at this time. Parents are encouraged to attend our closing ceremony at 9:30am in the Activity Center. Please note: Campers will not be released until his/her cabin counselor has checked and approved the cleanliness of the cabin.

We are planning a very exciting week for our campers. Some special events that you can look forward to will include a sharing celebration, and an evening swim/pizza party. Please bring any musical instruments and talent ideas for our sharing celebration. Sometimes a special stuffed friend to stuff in a sleeping bag is a great comfort for nighttime.
